ANNOUNCEMENT No. 01 Regarding the organization of The 5th Student Conference on Pharmacy Research - 2026

I. PURPOSE - SIGNIFICANCE

- To promote scientific research activities among students at Pham Ngoc Thach University of Medicine (PNTU) and within the broader student community majoring in healthcare and related fields;
- To provide opportunities for networking, learning, and exchanging study tips, as well as research experiences for students from both inside and outside the university;
- To foster students' awareness of their role, which builds a solid foundation for their careers and subsequent educational pursuit after graduation;
- To acknowledge and reward students who do outstanding scientific research projects.

II. TIME - LOCATION - PARTICIPANTS

2.1. Time

- Registration : From December 1st, 2025 to March 1st, 2026

- Abstract submission : From February 1st, 2026 to March 31st, 2026

- Abstract evaluation : From April 1st, 2026 to April 14th, 2026

- Products submission : From April 15th, 2026 to April 29th, 2026

- Exhibitions and Presentations: From May 15th, 2026 to May 16th, 2026

2.2. Location

The Conference will be conducted onsite at Pham Ngoc Thach University of Medicine and online via MS Teams platform.

2.3. Participants

Students from universities, academies, and colleges across Asia studying in healthcare or closely related fields, whose research projects are related to the field of Pharmacy are eligible. Specifically:

- Pharmaceutical Science (PS): Research related to pharmaceutics, quality control, toxicity, experimenting pharmacological effects of various types of drugs, cosmetics, dietary supplements; studies involving pre-clinical or clinical trials; research on new therapeutic methods; studies on medicinal plants; research on manufacturing processes on an industrial scale and studies on screening, synthesizing drug ingredients and excipients.



- Pharmaceutical Care (PC): Clinical pharmacy and pharmacotherapy research; studies in social pharmacy, community pharmacy, pharmacoeconomics, pharmacy administration, pharmacoepidemiology, health technology assessment, drug supply chain management, drug storage, and research on quality assurance in pharmaceutical education.

2.4. Rights and responsibilities of participants

Rights of participants

- To be evaluated and to receive feedback from the Expert Panel;
- Accepted Abstracts will be published in the Conference Proceedings;
- Full-text manuscript will be selected for publication in the Pham Ngoc Thach Medical Journal (upon request);
 - To receive a bilingual Certificate of Participation and a Conference Badge;
 - To be eligible for Conference Awards;
 - To be considered for Conference Awards and Certificates of Merit.

Especially for presenters:

- Present in person at PNTU;
- Receive Conference gifts;
- In the case of presenters from other cities, those who meet the eligibility criteria by the Organizing Committee may apply for grants during the Conference period, covering accommodation, meals, and local transportation, **excluding** flight ticket. Please note that the grants apply only to presenters and do not extend to other participants, including supervisors.

Responsibilities of participants

- Register and submit Abstracts and Products in accordance with the Organizing Committee's regulations;
 - Pay participation fee;
 - Participate in activities within the Conference framework.

III. REGISTRATION CATEGORIES

Participants are allowed to register for more than one topic. Each registered topic can be in either of the two categories below:

- Poster session
- Oral session: In this category, participants can choose language of presentation English or Vietnamese.
 - Products requirements (Abstract/ Poster/ Powerpoint):
 - + All products must be presented in English;
- + The presentation format and design template will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Participants must be the authors of the research projects (either the main author or co-authors), and each project may have up to five authors. The number of projects registered by each participant is unlimited.
- Registered projects must not have been submitted to any scientific research competitions before the conference and must obtain approval from supervising lecturers for participation.

IV. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

 - Step 2. Submit the Abstract.
- Step 3. Receive notification of whether the project meets the competition requirements.
 - Step 4. For the accepted Abstract, pay the participant fee.
