CONFERENCE INFORMATION

The 5th Student Conference on Pharmacy Research

I. OBJECTIVE

- Promote scientific research activities among students at Pham Ngoc Thach University of Medicine (PNTU) as well as the student community in healthcare sectors and the related fields.
- Facilitate opportunities for exchanging, learning, sharing experience in studying and scientific research for both internal and external students.
- Cultivate students' awareness of their responsibilities, laying a strong foundation for their future careers and postgraduate studies.
- Recognize and acknowledge students with exceptional scientific research.

II. PARTICIPANTS

Students from universities, academies, and colleges across Asia studying in healthcare or closely related fields, whose research projects are related to the field of Pharmacy, are eligible. Specifically:

- Pharmaceutical Science (PS): Research related to pharmaceutics, quality control, toxicity, experimenting pharmacological effects of various types of drugs, cosmetics, dietary supplements; studies involving pre-clinical or clinical trials; research on new therapeutic methods; studies on medicinal plants; research on manufacturing processes on an industrial scale and studies on screening, synthesizing drug ingredients and excipients.
- **Pharmaceutical Care (PC)**: Clinical pharmacy and pharmacotherapy research; studies in social pharmacy, community pharmacy, pharmacoeconomics, pharmacy administration, pharmacoepidemiology, health technology assessment, drug supply chain management, drug storage, and research on quality assurance in pharmaceutical education.





III. TIME AND FORM OF ORGANIZATION

3.1. Time of organization

- Registration: December 1, 2025 to March 1, 2026

- Abstract submission: February 1, 2026 to March 31, 2026

- Topic approval: April 1, 2026 to April 14, 2026

- Product submission: April 15, 2026 to April 29, 2026

- Exhibition and presentation: May 15, 2026 to May 16, 2026

The official session of the Conference is expected to take place in 2 days, from May 15 to May 16, 2026 at Pham Ngoc Thach University of Medicine (567 Nguyen Cuu Phu, Tan Nhut Commune, Ho Chi Minh City).

3.2. Form of organization

- Poster presentation: the product is presented in a **STANDEE** form, and the reporter delivers their presentations and discusses **DIRECTLY** at the poster exhibition session.
- Oral presentation: the product is presented in the form of powerpoint, and will be presented **DIRECTLY** at the conference hall or **ONLINE** via the MS-Teams platform at the oral presentation session.

IV. REQUIREMENTS, RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTICIPANTS

4.1. Requirements

- Participants can register to participate in the conference individually or in groups (no more than **05 participants**, including supervisors).
- + Individual: 01 participant, supervisor and co-authors.
- + Group: from 02 participants, supervisor and co-authors.

Note

- + Participants: receive a certificate.
- + Supervisor and Co-Author: **do not** receive a certificate, their name is shown on the presentation and the abstract book.
- The participant must be the author of the topic (first author/ corresponding author/ co-author). There is no limit to the number of topics registered for each participant.





- The topic must have confirmation from the supervisors (no more than **02 supervisors**) for permission to participate in the Conference.
- Each topic has **only 01 presenter**. The presenter must possess the status of being a student. The presenter will receive all benefits and gifts according to the regulations of the organization, the remaining participants (**if registered as a group**) only receive certificates and lanyards.

4.2. Rights

- To be evaluated and to receive feedback from the Expert Panel;
- Accepted Abstracts will be published in the Conference Proceedings;
- Full-text manuscript will be selected for publication in the Pham Ngoc Thach Medical Journal *(upon request)*;
- To receive a bilingual Certificate of Participation and a Conference Badge;
- To be eligible for Conference Awards;
- To be considered for Conference Awards and Certificates of Merit.

Especially for presenters:

- Present in person at PNTU;
- Receive Conference gifts;
- In the case of presenters from other cities, those who meet the eligibility criteria by the Organizing Committee may apply for grants during the Conference period, covering accommodation, meals, and local transportation, excluding flight ticket. Please note that the grants apply only to presenters and do not extend to other participants, including supervisors.

4.3. Responsibilities

- Register and submit abstract and poster/oral presentation accordance with organizing committee regulations;
- Pay the participation fee;
- Participate in activities within the conference.





V. REGISTRATION

- Step 1. Register at the Registration Form or scan the QR code
- Step 2. Submit the abstract at the Abstract Submission
- **Step 3.** Receive notifications about the topic approval via mail
- **Step 4.** Confirm the edited abstract from the Expert Panel (send via mail)
- **Step 5.** Submit your presentation (poster/ powerpoint) along with the participation fee transfer receipt via the **Presentation Submission**
- Step 6. Participate in the conference

7.1. Overall procedure

- The types of the study must be original research, systematic review or meta analysis, other types will not be approved, e.g. editorials, commentary, corrigendum/erratum, case report/ case series report, expert opinion, hypothesis, photo essays, study protocol, research letter, etc.
- English should be used in all documents including Abstract, Poster (including subtitles), Powerpoint.
- Each study can only be registered under one of the two categories Poster or Oral.





7.2. Regulations of topic summary (Abstract)

- Participants write the abstract according to the template provided by the organizing committee. Download template at: **Abstract Template- SCPR2026**.
- The abstract is presented in a Word file with the extension ".docx".
- The abstract will be published in the Book of Abstracts if approved.
- Participants may only submit the abstract once.

The abstract will be sent to the scientific council for revision. In case the abstract needs refinement, the organizing committee will notify participants via email. Please check and modify the abstract then send the final version back to the organizing committee within the required time.

There are 2 rounds of Abstract edit in maximum. Abstracts which are overdue or unsatisfactory after 02 rounds will be rejected and no fee will be refunded. In other cases, the organizing committee is not responsible.

7.3. Poster presentation

- Content requirements: present a summary of the outstanding and important contents about the study/ project, including the following parts:
- (i) Title of the study in CAPITAL and in **bold**;
- (ii) Names of authors and agencies, corresponding author is marked with an asterisk (*), and author, who is presenter, should be written in <u>underlined</u>;
- (iii) Corresponding author's email. Ex: Corresponding author: abc@gmail.com;
- (iv) Introduction: Problem statement and Goals of research;
- (v) Materials and Methods;
- (vi) Results;
- (vii) Conclusion;
- (viii) References.





- Format requirements:

+ Product size: 800 x 1300 mm, Portrait.

+ Minimum resolution: 150 ppi.

Export the file as a pdf to allow for the CMYK printing color system.

+ Font: sans serif.

+ Font size: at least 16 pt.

- Report language: Vietnamese.

- Scoring scale:

Design and content: 80%.

Answer questions from the council: 20%.

Note:

- Authors may only present the study content as requested above (i to viii) in the design area (do not mention the name and the logo of the conference).

- Participants will be asked to present DIRECTLY at the exhibition session within the time frame specified by the organizing committee to present their products and answer questions from the council (*if required*).
- Studies registered as a Poster presentation are allowed to participate in "**The most Impressive Prize**", which are voted on the official fanpage of the conference.

7.4. Oral presentation

- Participants can choose to present at the English or Vietnamese section and to present in-person or virtually through MS-Teams. In case of any changes, participants should promptly inform the organizing committee for adjustment;
- Products (**Poster/Powerpoint**) will be published on media platforms of the conference with a brief summary of the research project if it is satisfactory after the evaluation by the council.
- Content requirements: present a summary of the outstanding and important contents about the study/ project, including the following parts:
- (i) Title of the study in CAPITAL and in **bold**;
- (ii) Names of authors and agencies, corresponding author is marked with an asterisk (*), and author, who is presenter, should be written in underlined;





- (iii) Corresponding author's email. Ex: Corresponding author: abc@gmail.com;
- (iv) Introduction: Problem statement and Goals of research;
- (v) Materials and Methods;
- (vi) Results;
- (vii) Conclusion;
- (viii) References.

- Format requirements:

- + Powerpoint is designed according to the template provided by the Organizing Committee. Download sample at: **PPT Template-SCPR2026**.
- + Maximum number of slides: 10.
- + Slide size: standard (4:3), Landscape, Slide sized for widescreen.
- + Font: sans serif.
- + Font size: at least 16.

- Scoring scale:

Design and content: 80%.

Report (maximum 05 minutes) and answer questions from the council (maximum 10 minutes): 20%.

Note:

- The participant is allotted 5 minutes to present and 10 minutes to receive feedback and answer questions from the council.
- Studies registered as an Oral presentation with Powerpoint are **NOT** allowed to participate in "**The most Impressive Prize**" on the official fanpage of the conference.

7.5. How to submit your work

At each stage, presenters will receive official notifications via email from the organizing committee. Reporters kindly adhere to the guidelines on content, format, and time. To ensure the accuracy of submitted documents, participants please send original files of Abstract/Poster//Powerpoint that meet the requirements with their PDF version.





7.6. Check for plagiarism

Plagiarism is the deliberate or unintentional act of authors using someone else's words, paragraphs, articles, figures, photos, facts, or ideas and passing them off as their own in their academic products, without properly crediting the source. This is considered a serious violation of ethical standards in scholarship that cannot be ignored.

After submission, the Organizing Committee will check reporters' documents for plagiarism by using Turnitin. Documents that have less than a 20% similarity score will be acceptable. If there is more than 20% resemblance, the writers will be requested to revise their work. Any products that are not edited within the time limit or do not reach the required Turnitin score will be rejected.

The Organizing Committee recommends the authors who have access to Turnitin to check for plagiarism by themselves and attach the plagiarism detector's reports when submitting products. Authors must take responsibility if there is an issue pertaining to the copyrights and research ethics of papers submitted. The Organizing Committee is not responsible for providing plagiarism - checking tools to participants.
